This Summer – 6:30 PM


Planning to enjoy sunny weekends at the cottage this summer? Work shifts that sometimes keep you away from Sunday mornings?

Poverty, illiteracy and malnutrition are some of the challenges of the Soura community. Pray for these widows as they seek alternative sources of income and care for their children. Pray that they would not be discouraged and would feel loved and accepted by their community. May the God of comfort encourage them during their time of need and give them grace for each day.
