Emerging Generation Coordinator Proposal / Congregational Meeting on Wed January 26

Background: The Pastoral Search Team received an application in December from a candidate who has experience and passion for youth and children's ministry but without pastoral credentials or education. Having had few applications for the position, and recognizing the giftings of this particular candidate, a few members of the Search Team met with her to determine her suitability and her intentions in submitting an application. After that meeting the members of the team were impressed with her testimony, energy, experience and passion for youth and children. In the absence of any other suitable applicants for this position, they decided to send a proposal to the Leadership Board that adjustments be made to the job description which might better fit the role they believed this candidate could fulfill.

Proposal: The new proposal for an Emerging Generation Ministry Coordinator position can be found in the congregation email and church website, but the major differences from the previous pastoral position are:

- Change from Pastor to Coordinator.
- Change from full-time to three-quarter-time.
- Change from "children, youth and young adult ministries" to "children and youth ministries."
- No requirement for "Accreditation by, or willingness to enter the process to be accredited by, the Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada Board of Ministerial Standards and Education."
- No expectation to be part of the regular worship speaker rotation.
- It would be a one-year contract position to be evaluated after 11 months to determine the effectiveness of the position in meeting the ministry needs of Grace Memorial.

Rationale: The removal of the Young Adult category from the job description is a recognition of the candidate's age and experience. The change from full to three-quarter time, is a reflection of fewer expectations for this position with the removal of the young adult ministries and some pastoral roles. A one-year contract, will give us a season of ministry to evaluate the effectiveness of the position. If in a year's time, we think, it is working well, we can recommend to continue or even expand. But if in a year's time, we think the position does need pastoral experience, we can explore different paths or options.



Meet the Candidate - Emily Colpitts

Some of the Grace Memorial Community may remember Emily from her volunteer work with our summer camps. She is a native Frederictonian and a member of Brunswick Street Baptist. We asked her to introduce herself and she sent the following:

Hello, my name is Emily Colpitts. I was born and raised here in Fredericton and have had the privilege of being involved in the local church community. I've been married for almost two years now and met my wonderful husband Isaac Colpitts through the campus ministries, IVCF.

Over the past seven years, I've had the privilege of working in both the Children and Youth Ministry. I've worked locally at Greenhill Lake Camp and as far as Yarmouth, Nova Scotia, at Camp Peniel. In addition, I have been a youth leader at Brunswick Street Baptist Church for four years now and recently filled the Interim Youth Coordinator Position during a time of transition.

Within the first five minutes of meeting me, you'll realize that I am a bundle of energy and enthusiasm. In saying that, my friends would describe me as "the mom friend," as I'm always there with a first aid kit, sunscreen, and a labelled itinerary for the day.

My long-term life goals are to work in kids and youth ministry for as long as I can, and in the places I lack formal education, I make up for with experience, dedication, and a willingness to learn and grow.

VIRTUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING - 7:30 PM on WEDNESDAY JANUARY 26th

Recognizing this is a different position than the one the church voted for at the Annual Meeting in 2021, Leadership would like to seek the approval of the congregation for this direction. A special virtual congregational meeting will be held at 7:30 PM on Wednesday January 26th using Zoom. Leadership thought it was important to seek approval at the earliest convenience in order to provide much needed assistance to our current staff. At the same time, recognizing the province is discouraging large gatherings, they thought a Zoom Congregational Meeting would be more appropriate. If, however, there is a member who would like to participate but who does not have the capability of connecting virtually, we will seek to set up something at the church building to help that person connect. One would need to contact the church office on or before Friday January 21st to allow time to set this up. The Emerging Generation Coordinator position will be the only item on the agenda.

NOMINATION SUGGESTIONS

The Leadership Board has begun the process of seeking the people God is calling to leading roles within the church, to be voted on at the Annual Meeting in February 2022.

Please prayerfully consider these needs. At present we are seeking nominations for:

Leadership Board: This board meets monthly and is responsible for policy, mission, goals and oversight of the Senior Pastor.

Fellowship Ministry Coordinator: This person coordinates ministries which foster opportunities for fellowship and welcoming people. They oversee the Ushers, Greeters and Catering types of ministries.

Connection Ministry Coordinator: This person coordinates ministries which seek to help the congregation stay connected as a people of God including: oversight of visitation ministries, new members and baptism, Benevolent Fund, the Prayerline, Prayer Ministry Team, and helping newcomers integrate into the church community.

Discipleship Ministry Coordinator: This person coordinates and provides leadership to the ministries, which seek to grow passionate disciples of all ages, particularly through education and development of leaders. This team will give oversight to such ministries as: Children's Church, youth and children's programs, small group ministries; young adult, family, and adult programs.

Audit Committee This team meets once annually (usually in January) to go over the church's financial records for the previous year.

We are deeply appreciative of all those who have served, especially through the challenging period of both COVID and staff transitions. The Leadership Board welcomes your suggestions and nominations which can be made either in a written note or email submitted through the church office. Thank you!

WAYS TO GIVE – Thank you for your faithful giving during this period when many find it difficult. It is a blessing to our Grace Community of Faith.

We currently have four methods of giving:

AT WORSHIP — At each of the three doors to the sanctuary, there are offering boxes just inside the room. You can drop your offering into one of those boxes at any worship service.

MANY PEOPLES - ONE COMMUNITY

GRACE WORSHIP & NEWEST PROVINCIAL COVID PRECAUTIONS: As you may know, the provincial government has brought in new procedures requiring Proof of Vaccination and Mandatory Masking. These policies do apply to our worship gatherings. We are implementing the following in compliance with the provincial government regulations.

- Please use the Welcome Centre doors to enter the building.
- Those age 12 and older will be asked to provide suitable proof of vaccination. The government website reads: "Proof of vaccination may be provided by showing an immunization record or a photograph of an immunization record from a regional health authority clinic, pharmacy or Public Health. New Brunswickers' can also show proof of vaccination by using the MyHealthNB portal. People who have been vaccinated outside the province may provide proof of vaccination from that jurisdiction."
- Masks are required to be worn while in the building, including during the worship service and at children's church.
- Print copies of the monthly Bulletin and weekly Grace Notes are available in the entry to the sanctuary.
- If you are feeling unwell or feeling uncomfortable with in-person events, please avail yourself of the online worship option. You can find the worship live stream service online on our YouTube channel or watch a recording later.
