EXTRA INFORMATION FROM OUR LEADERS

Kate Thompson: Mostly young professionals and married couples in their 20's to 40's. Some studies are based on books of the Bible, while others are more thematic. Each session we study, chat, and end the sessions by praying with and for each other. We typically complete 4 - 5 studies per year based on input from the group.

Roger & Marilyn Crisp: **One at a Time** - Without a doubt, Jesus is the person who has made the biggest difference in all of history. So, how did He do it? If we study His life from the Gospels, there's one particular phrase that captures how Jesus had such an impact: one at a time. Kyle Idleman hosts this 7-part study; format: video and discussion.

Ed Corey: **Belonging: Accessibility, Inclusion, and Christian Community** - God created all of us for relationship with God and each other - including those with visible and invisible disabilities. During this 9-session study we will look at attitudes and systems of ableism that create barriers and even lead to deep hurt preventing some believers from participating in God's kingdom work.

Pastor Peter Lohnes: Tuesdays, 7-9:00 PM starting September 19. Following up on the Emotionally Healthy Spirituality Course in the spring, you are invited to join us this fall for the **Emotionally Healthy Relationship Course (EHRC)**. This powerful course will equip you with practical tools to really love people in difficult situations and to grow into a mature follower of Jesus. Over the eight sessions, we will learn to practice the way of Jesus in our relationships by speaking truth in love, living faithfully into our God-given limitations, learning to treat others with dignity and grace, and making peace in times of conflict. The group will meet for four weeks **starting September 19**, then take a three-week break, before finishing the last four sessions in November. Workbooks for the course are \$30.



SPECIAL THANKSGIVING PROJECT

Did you know that each year our Benevolent Fund assists dozens of households? Fall can be a challenging time of the year with the need to purchase back-to-school supplies and the heating season starting. Sometimes doing something special to remember to be thankful, is not in the budget (like a meal with family and friends). So, this year again, we're preparing **20 Thanksgiving Boxes** which along with the turkey will include all the fixings for a amazing Thanksgiving dinner. There will be people there to answer questions and to help if you wish to know more or to become involved in something that interests you.

BEHZAD IS COMING SOON!


We got word earlier this month that Behzad Firouzabadi will be arriving on **September 15** (assuming there are no flight delays). Behzad is a Christian who had to flee Iran because of his Christian faith and has spent more than a decade in a refugee camp in Indonesia. We applied to bring him to Fredericton almost four years ago and after delays due to COVID and the Ukrainian crisis, he finally has a plane ticket to come to Canada. A small support team has been formed and will be working with Behzad his first year as we support him during his adjustment to life in Canada. But you can help!

Here are four ways right now:

1. **Meet Behzad at the Fredericton Airport:** Right now, the flight is scheduled to arrive at **5:20 PM** on **Friday, September 15**. It would be great to have a large group of folks just to express our "Welcome to Fredericton and Welcome to Grace."
2. **Welcome Behzad at Homecoming Sunday:** His first Sunday is **Homecoming Sunday** and we will take time in the service to introduce him to the congregation. Take time to just shake his hand and express a warm welcome to the Grace community.
3. **Donations:** As the team meets to discern needs and establish a home for Behzad, they make ask for some donations in kind. Things you might have and no longer need, or might be interested in buying to give. Look for more details in the weeks to come.
4. **Give to Refugee Sponsorship:** We are anticipating a budget of about \$15,000.00 to support Behzad through this first year. We are reaching out to some outside groups and friends, and there will be a special appeal at Thanksgiving, but if you would like to donate towards his support, you can do so through your church envelope or through your regular e-transfer. Just mark the donation "Refugee Sponsorship."

We are excited for this opportunity to bless someone who literally gave up everything to follow Christ.
