EASTER THROUGH THE EYES OF PETER

Join us this year for Holy Week as we see the story of Easter through the eyes of one of Jesus' closest followers, the apostle Peter. From the great celebration to the great betrayal to the amazing resurrection, discover the good news of grace this Easter.

Sunday April 13th – Palm Sunday: 10:30 AM Palm Sunday Intergenerational Worship Celebration.

Join us for a time of celebration as we see Jesus arrive triumphantly in Jerusalem, humbly riding on a donkey. Special music will include the Children's Choir, we will all get to see celebration of Jesus as King from Peter's unique perspective.

Wednesday April 16th: 7:00 PM Shadow of the Cross Service – This reflective service of hymns, prayers and communion as we gain Peter's perspective of the moments on the eve of the crucifixion – the Last Supper, Prayer in the Garden and Peter's response to Jesus' arrest.

Friday April 18th: 10:30 AM Good Friday Service at Brunswick Street Baptist – A special time of worship which brings together Grace, Faith Baptist, and Brunswick Street Baptist churches with a combined choir, and three short messages from the Gospel of John as we see the impact of Jesus' sacrifice on our life today. UPDATE FROM THE 2025 VISION TEAM: Thank you to everyone who participated in giving input to the **2025 Vision Team**. Over 70 individuals contribute to the process through small group discussions, surveys, emails or listening sessions over the course of a month. All of the input, along with research

on our changing community and the demographics of our congregation has been gathered and the team is currently reading and sifting through the material as they seek to discern God's unique calling for Grace over the next three to five years. As the team goes through the material, they will be looking for theme and commonalities which God seems to be highlighting for us as a congregation. As they determine a number of these key points, they will begin to prayerfully prioritize them and then create a vision / goal document which will eventually be shared with the congregation for our feedback and reflection. The team is following a process similar to one recently used by our denomination in developing its own five-year emphasis. Please Pray! Prayer is a key part of this period of discernment. Each week there is a group of people gathering to pray at noon hour on Thursdays and each of our Groups have a prayer session at each of their gatherings. Please continue to pray for the team's vision process during your own quiet times with God.



Weekly Prayer Emphasis for Vision Team:

- ★ **March 31- April 5:** Pray for the team as they each continue to go through the input from the congregation along with other research seeking the key points God is calling us to focus on for the next few years.
- ★ **April 6-12:** As the team meets this week, pray that God will help them to discern His priorities for Grace in the next few years and bring clarity to their work.
- ★ **April 13-19:** As the team takes some time to reflect during this Holy Week, pray God will help them to begin to form into words some of the vision He has in store for Grace.
- ★ **April 20-26:** Easter is a moment of celebration which redefined faith and enlarged our understanding of what God can do. As we begin to live in the light of what God can do, pray for the Vision team to have great faith and hope in developing the first draft of the vision statement.
- ★ **April 27-May 3:** Continue to pray for God's guidance as the Team works on completing a first draft and begins to share some of what they understand God to be saying through this process.

THURSDAY PRAYER LUNCHES



Join us weekly on Thursdays from Noon to 1 pm in the Family Centre for a time of lunch and prayer. So far, we have had four to eight people enjoying a time of fellowship and prayer each week. We spend the first thirty minutes nourishing the body with a light lunch of soup and bread (no dessert) and then second thirty minutes nourishing our souls in prayer. We will aim to be done on time to get you back to work or on with the rest of your afternoon. No praying experience necessary, and no one will be put on the spot. This prayer element in our church life is critical, especially in this season of discernment as we seek God's direction for Grace.

COMMUNITY IMPACT PARTNER PROGRAM: In partnership with JoyFm and a dozen other churches across the city, each month we are highlighting the work of a nonprofit agency seeking to make a difference in Fredericton. These agencies are working with the vulnerable, people dealing with food or housing insecurity and making a positive impact in our community. Along with highlighting the work of each nonprofit, each month will also include a hands-on project in support of that agency.

OPPORTUNITIES TO GIVE AT GRACE

THERE ARE 4 PRIMARY FUNDS TO WHICH PEOPLE DESIGNATE OFFERINGS:

CURRENT – The Ministry of Grace. This fund supports everything we do as a congregation.

MISSIONS - Supporting our Ministry Partners:

This fund supports our donations to our partners such as Canadian Baptist Ministries (around the world) Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada (Atlantic Provinces), Baptist Chaplaincy in the hospitals, Greenhill Lake Camp, Acadia Divinity College, Crandall University, and more.

BUILDING – Major Property Repairs: This fund is used to help with major repairs to the church building such as a roof.

BENEVOLENT – People in Emergency Need: This fund is used to help congregants and community people when they are facing a financial crisis for whatever reason.
