




## Messages this month



## LUNCH & ANNUAL GENERAL BUSINESS MEETING ~ SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 22ND



### The Vision

We aren't just hosting another outreach church event; we are creating a "third space" or a "safe space" to enjoy dinner and conversation. This space and event isn't in a home and isn't a traditional church event; instead, the intention is a neutral space to allow curiosity to grow. It is an invitation for people to explore the trustworthiness of the Bible story. The Logic of Agape is designed specifically for our friends, neighbours, and even coworkers who might find church intimidating or irrelevant in today's culture. Through the experience of enjoying food, music, and honest storytelling, we want to show the Gospel isn't a set of rules, but a radical, unconventional love that is deeply relevant to our modern lives.



### The Invite

The wording on the front of the invitation card is designed to gain attention and hopefully invite curiosity. It intentionally has a very non-church feel, and the scripture is based on Ecclesiastes 2:1-10 from Solomon. Interestingly, this type of lifestyle has been present throughout time with the same results. Because this event is created for the "unchurched/it's been a long time/I used to go when I was young..etc", the most effective invitation is going to be from you personally. How to share this event? Be excited but don't "preach" the invite, instead try handing them an invitation card, mention the details on the back. Say something like "My church is hosting an evening of great food, music, and some honest conversation about love and grace. I'd love for you to join me and check it out." Assure them they will not be singled out or pressured, and it's not a sermon. They are our guests invited to an evening of music, dinner, and conversation. A safe space to ask questions or just listen.


