**SUMMER FAMILY FOOD BACKPACK PROGRAM: VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

During the school year, local schools partner with the Fredericton Community Kitchens to send backpacks of non-perishable food home with children in need. But what happens when school is out for the summer?

To ensure these families still get support, Grace will serve as the south-side pickup location this summer.

**How It Works**

- The Food: Sorted and provided entirely by the Fredericton Community Kitchens.
- The Pickup: Client families will pick up their food backpacks at Grace on **Wednesdays** between 10:00 AM and 12:00 PM.
- The Timeline: The program runs for 8 weeks, from **July 8th to August 26th**.

- We need 2 to 3 volunteers who can share the schedule over these 8 weeks. Ideally, we need at least one volunteer on-site each Wednesday to: Greet the families and hand out the food and keep a simple track of which schools the families represent.

## Summer Camp

Registration is open on our webpage [gracememorial.ca](http://gracememorial.ca), and we have a very exciting lineup this year! Camps are for children who have completed from Primary to Grade 5, based on the school year just completed. There is limited enrollment (30 kids and we are already half-full), and **early registration is encouraged**. Registration costs remain the same this year at \$115 per week, and is secured with payment. Each camp will run Monday to Friday from 9 AM to 4 PM, with options for an earlier drop-off or later pick-up for an extra charge.



**World Cup Camp – July 13 to 17** The eyes of the world will be on Canada, Mexico, and the US this July as the World Cup tournament is hosted in North America this summer. This fun week or camp, during the World Cup, will include learning some soccer skills, playing games, along with crafts, and all the other fun things of summer camps.

### Rainforest Falls – July 27 to 31

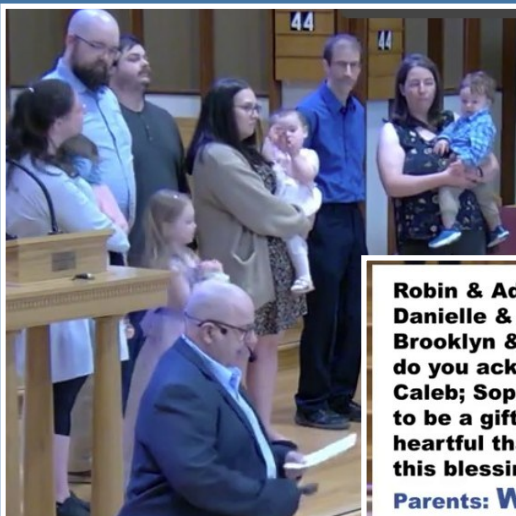

- ◆ **MISSIONS** - Supporting our Ministry Partners: This fund supports our donations to our partners such as Canadian Baptist Ministries (around the world) Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada (Atlantic Provinces), Baptist Chaplaincy in the hospitals, Greenhill Lake Camp, Acadia Divinity College, Crandall University, and more.
- ◆ **BUILDING** – Major Property Repairs: This fund is used to help with major repairs to the church building such as a roof.
- ◆ **BENEVOLENT** – People in Emergency Need: This fund is used to help congregants and community people when they are facing a financial crisis for whatever reason.
