UPDATE FROM THE PASTORAL SEARCH COMMITTEE: For several months, the Pastoral Search Committee has been interviewing a candidate via Zoom who we felt could be a good fit for our church. In late July, a small group met with the candidate and his family in person. While it was a wonderful meeting, the committee ultimately felt an uncomfortable level of uncertainty regarding whether the fit was right, and made the decision not to move forward with his candidacy. Since then, we have reviewed the job description and updated the role title to "Next Generations Pastor." This aligns with our denomination's recent shift to "NextGen" ministry and reflects the most widely recognized term for this role across ministry circles. The position has been reposted on several job boards, and we are actively reaching out to Christian colleges, universities, and ministry contacts to spread the word. Please continue to pray for our committee as we seek wisdom and discernment, and pray that God makes His chosen candidate clear to us. In the meantime, we are deeply grateful that our incredible team of volunteer leaders in both children's and youth ministries have agreed to lead again this fall.

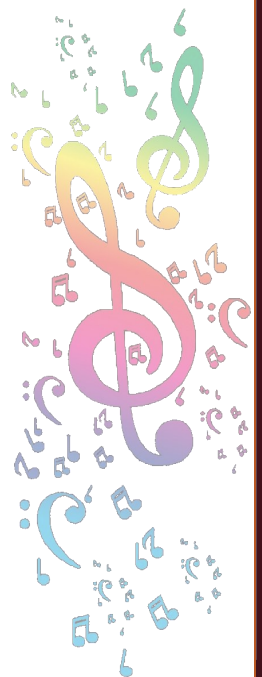
